Welcome

Congratulations on owning HOKU™, the new 360° multiplayer backyard toss game. This guide will show you how to set up, play, and care for your HOKU set. You may want to keep it on hand for easy reference.

What's Included

A) Game Board (1)

B) Throwing Stars (3 triangle, 3 square)

C) Zip-Up Carrying Case (1)

Setup

1. Place the game board in an area with at least 10 feet of free space in one direction - the more space the better.
2. Divide the throwing stars between players. Each player gets three stars with the same identifying shapes (e.g. One player has squares. Another has triangles).



CAUTION: Wood pieces can cause damage or injury when thrown. Be sure your play area is clear of people and breakable objects. Recommended ages 13+.

Gameplay

The goal of the game is to score 9 points first.

1. Decide which player will toss first ("Player One").
2. Player One takes three steps away from the game board in any direction of their choosing.
3. Player One tosses their three stars consecutively toward the game board, aiming to score by getting a "HOKU" or landing stars close to the center of the game board (See "Two Ways to Score" to the right).
4. Other players take their turns, one at a time, tossing their three stars consecutively. Players are allowed to knock other players' stars out of the way.
5. At the end of the round, award three (3) points for each "HOKU" plus one (1) point to whoever tossed the star closest to the center of the board.
6. After the first round, the player in the lead tosses first and decides a new tossing location (They may choose a location further or closer than 3 steps).
7. The first player to score 9 points wins.

In the case of a tie: If two or more players are tied for nine (9) or more points at the end of a round, they can break the tie by playing a round of "sudden death" where the player with the most points after that round is the winner.

Two Ways to Score

“HOKU” (3 Points)

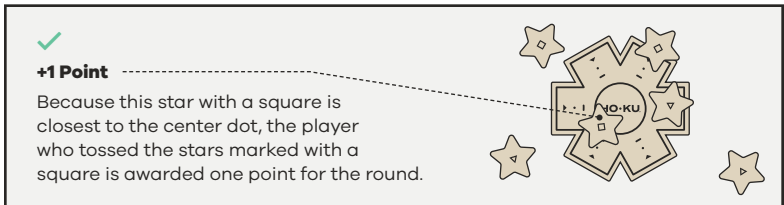
At the end of a round, if the point of one your stars breaks the plane of a notch in the board, you score 3 points.

Players can score multiple “HOKUs” in a round. **HOKUs do not count for stars leaning against or on top of the board.**



Closest to Center (1 Point)

At the end of a round, determine which star is closest to the center dot on the game board. The player who tossed that star is awarded one point. **The closest star does NOT need to be on the board to score the point.**



Care / Cleaning

To extend the life of your HOKU set, keep the equipment away from liquids, chemicals, humidity, and extreme temperatures.

Clean your HOKU game pieces with a soft, damp cloth.

From time to time, you may want to clean the game board and throwing stars more thoroughly using detergent with warm water or a wood polish. Before using any of these soaps or cleaning chemicals, apply a small amount to the bottom of the game board to make sure it doesn't discolor the material. Once you've confirmed it's safe to use, you can proceed cleaning the pieces thoroughly.
