What's Included

A) Collapsible Game Board (1)

B) Bean Bags (3 brown, 3 white)

C) Mesh Carrying Bag (1)

Setup

1. Unfold the legs underneath the game board fully and place the board in an area with at least 10 feet of free space in one direction - the more space the better.
2. Divide the bean bags between players. Each player gets three bags of a given color (e.g. One player has brown, another has white).

How to Play

Games are quick and easy. First to score exactly 9 wins.

1. Decide which player will toss first ("Player One").
2. Player One chooses the first tossing location by taking three steps away from the game board in any direction.
3. Player One tosses their three bags (consecutively) toward the game board, aiming to score one (1) point by making it through the hole or three (3) points by landing it on top of the board. (See "Two Ways to Score" →).
4. Other players take their turns, one at a time, tossing their three bags consecutively. Players are allowed to knock other players' bags out of the way.
5. At the end of a round, calculate each player's score. The player in the lead tosses first in the next round and decides the next tossing location - It can be different from the previous location and further than 3 steps. If players are tied for the lead, the player who has held the lead the longest chooses the spot and tosses first.
6. The first player to score EXACTLY 9 points wins.
7. If a player ends a round with MORE than 9 points, they start the next round with 6 points.
8. **In the case of a tie:** If two or more players are tied for 9 points at the end of a round, they can break the tie by playing a round of "sudden death" where the player with the most points after that round is the winner.

Two Ways to Score

In this example, Brown would score 7, and White would score 4.



Island Shot (3 Points)

At the end of a round, if your bag is on top of the board, you score 3 points. **Bags touching the ground do not count.**

In the Hole (1 Point)

At the end of a round, any of your bags that went in the hole are each worth 1 point (even if they got knocked in after initially landing on the board).

Note: Island Shot scoring may seem a little backwards if you're used to cornhole rules. Because of the size of the game board, it's actually harder to land a bag on the board than it is to make it in the hole.

Sometimes, especially when playing with four players, it's possible for bags to stack up under the hole so that a bag that would've gone through the hole can't fit and lands on the board. In this case, count those bags as Island Shots.

Care / Cleaning

To extend the life of your Island Shot, keep the equipment away from liquids, chemicals, humidity, and extreme temperatures. Clean your Island Shot game pieces with a soft, damp cloth. Do not wash bean bags in a laundry machine.
